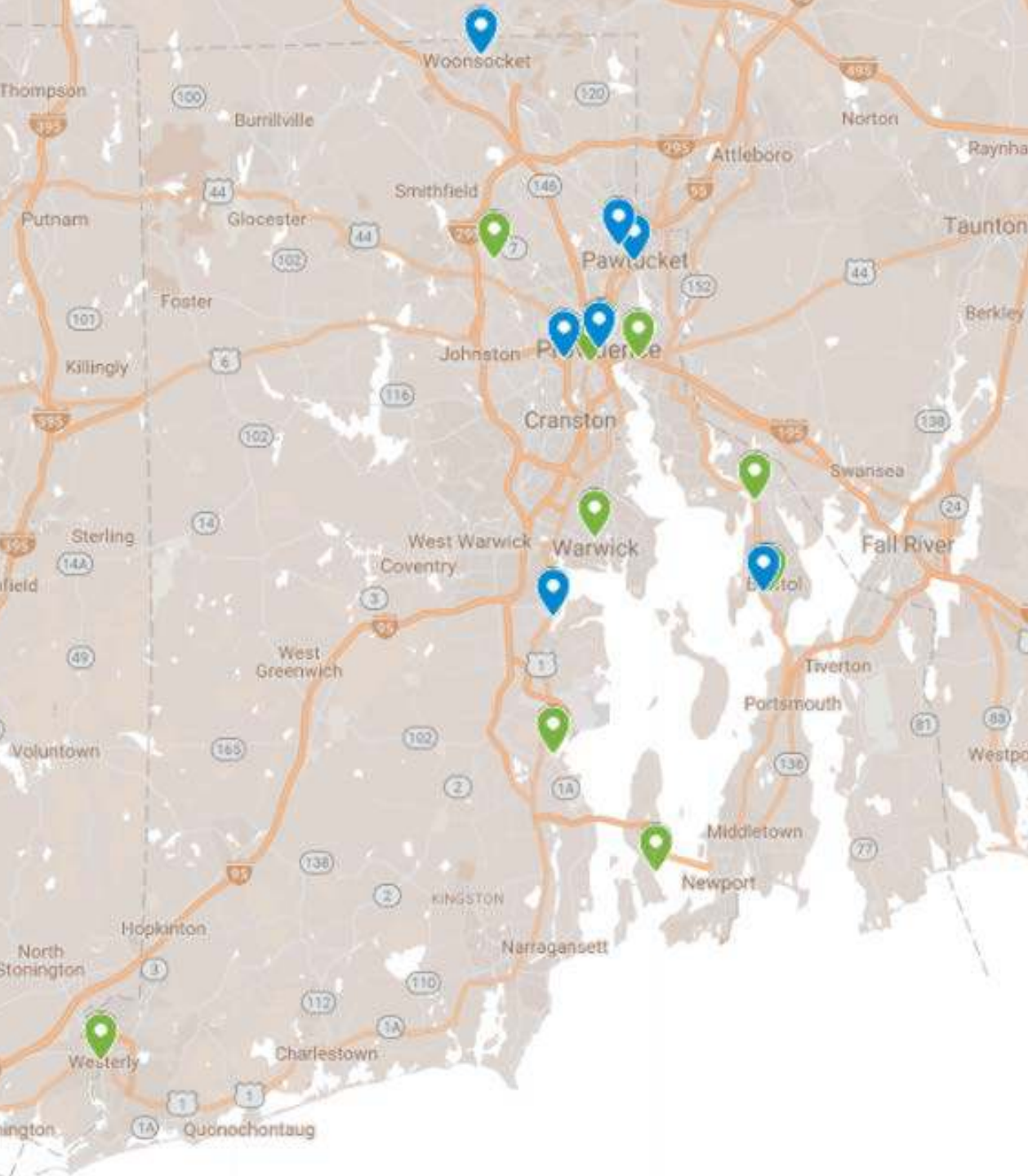

Main Street Streetscape Improvement Fund

DELIVERING RESULTS

FY 2016

[Blue]

Funded 7 projects for a total of \$999,400.

FY 2017

[Green]

Received 16 applications requesting \$3.3 million.

Recommending 9 Projects for a total of \$1 million.



Main Street Streetscape Improvement Fund

Recommending Awarding \$1,000,000 to 9 projects:

Bristol: \$42,855 for Wood Street Improvements

East Providence: \$75,000 for landscaping, lighting, and façade upgrades in Watchemoket Square

Jamestown: \$65,000 for East Ferry landscaping, crosswalks, paving, and stone seating walls

North Kingstown: \$204,400 for Wickford Waterfront Vision

Providence: \$189,145 for Decorative Lighting in Downtown and Improvements along Broad Street

Smithfield: \$11,075 for Bus Shelters & Signage

Warren: \$203,315 for Water Street Lighting & Street Trees

Warwick: \$69,000 for West Shore Road Crosswalks

Westerly: \$140,210 for Downtown sidewalks, crosswalks, and pedestrian signage

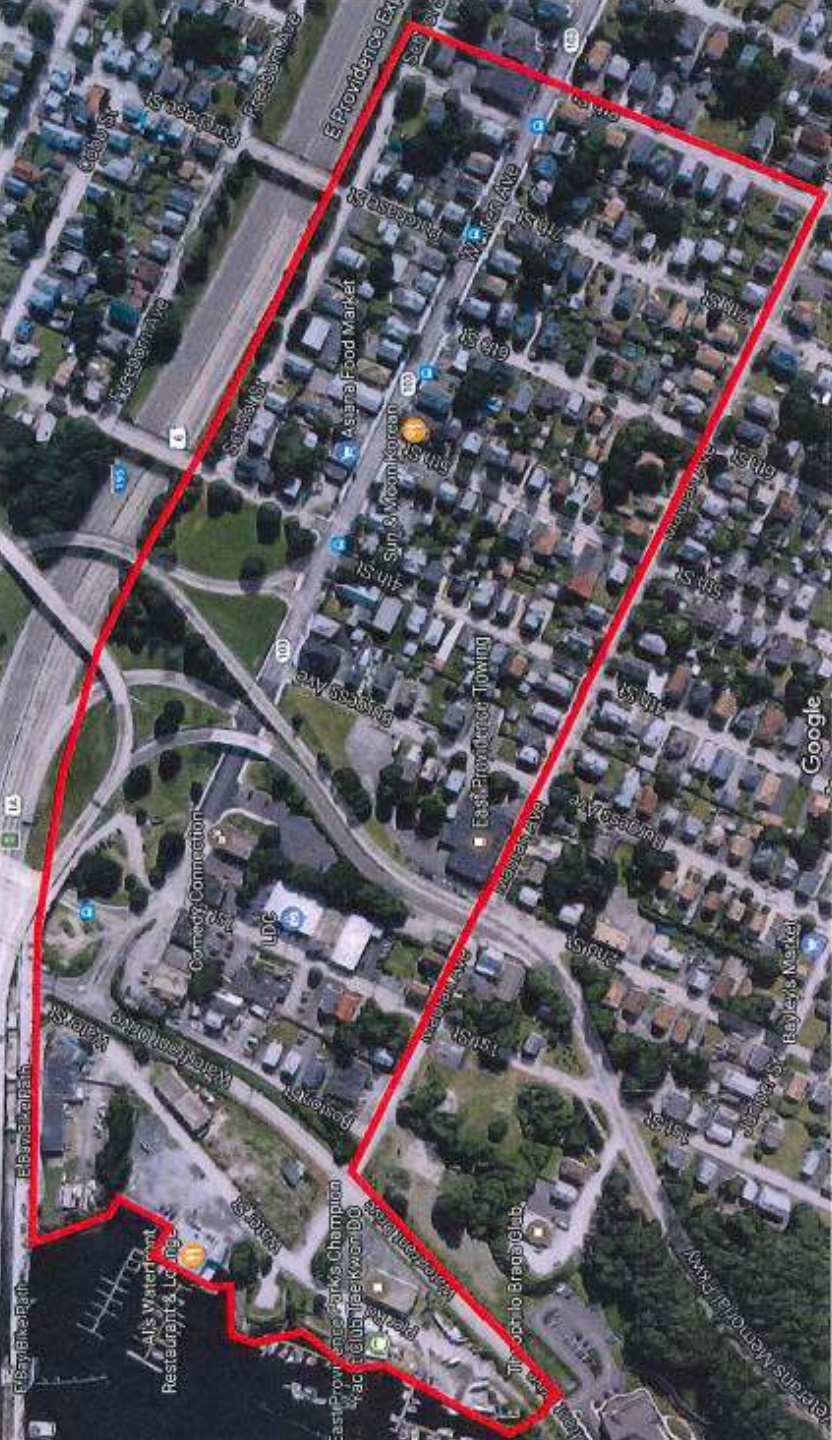

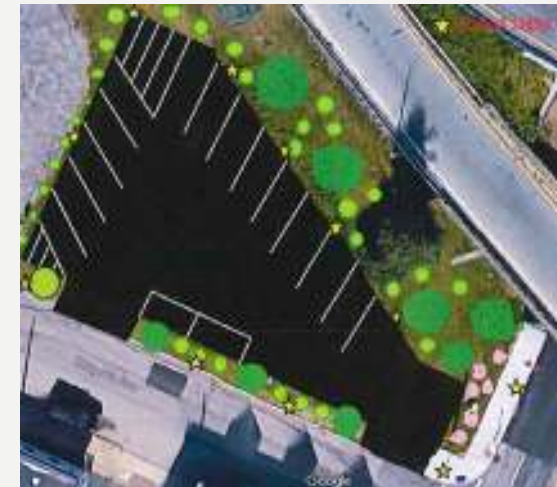

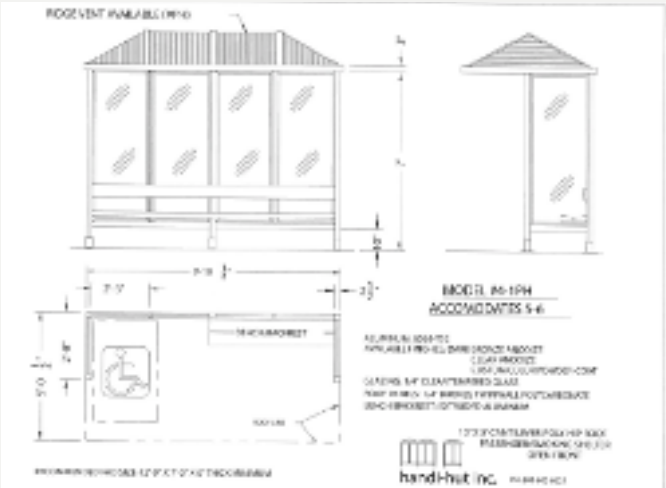
