Innovation Vouchers**

Rite-Solutions, Inc. | Middletown, RI | \$49,420 – Rite-Solutions, Inc. will continue its collaboration with the University of Rhode Island to incorporate state-of-the-art technologies like Artificial Intelligence/Deep Learning into its products and services to address complex, real world challenges of its Navy and commercial customers. Applicable for use in both the commercial and military marketplace, the Innovation Voucher focuses on the development of a new approach that couples machine learning with computational topology to improve the identification of objects using time-series sensor data.

Tank Vision, Inc. | Providence, RI | \$41,526 – Tank Vision, Inc. will use this voucher to work with the Design Lab at Brown University to validate accuracy and reliability of the company’s oil burner run-time monitor that is part of the tank monitoring product.

Trans-Tex, LLC | Cranston, RI | \$40,457 – Trans-Tex, LLC has recently begun production of sheet-based neoprene products and this voucher will be used to investigate substitution of laser technology for die cutting in the post printing process opening the door to production of a wider market of promotional products.
