

AMENDMENT TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Rhode Island Commerce Corporation has issued a Request for Proposals For: Grants Under the “Take it Outside” Initiative (the “RFP”), which is available here: https://commerceri.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/09/RFP_Take-it-Outside-Initiative.pdf. The following portions of the RFP are amended.

Eligible Entities and Eligible Expenses:

In the portion of the RFP entitled “Eligible Entities and Eligible Expenses,” the RFP states that Eligible Expenses include costs affiliated with purchasing, obtaining, delivering, installing, or otherwise enabling the use certain items between September 28, 2020 and December 18, 2020 (“Eligible Period”). Pursuant to this amendment, the Eligible Period is amended to be between **September 16, 2020 to December 18, 2020**.

The extension of the Eligible Period allows potential proposers to make Eligible Expenses before they submit a proposal to the RFP. However, if a potential proposer makes an Eligible Expense *before* the Corporation makes an award to that proposer under the RFP, if any, there is no guarantee that the proposer’s proposal will be awarded under the RFP or that the proposer will be reimbursed for that Eligible Expense under the Take it Outside Initiative. Accordingly, if a potential proposer makes an Eligible Expense *before* the Corporation makes any awards under the RFP, it does so at its own risk.
