Bank 5: Will accept PPP applications from non-customers, however, new customers must open an account prior to loan closing.

BankNewport: Will accept PPP applications from non-customers, however new customers must open a checking account before applying so funds may be deposited.

BankRI: Will be cutting off all new applications within the next couple of weeks.

BayCoast Bank: Accepting new PPP loan requests.

Berkshire Bank: Will accept PPP applications from non-customers. Berkshire's application portal will be on the bank's [website](#) once they go live.

Bristol County Savings Bank: The bank is accepting PPPs from both customers and non-customers until the new SBA expiration date or funding runs out.

Citizens Bank: Accepting applications from non-customers provided they open a checking account.
