Energy Storage Adder: REF will award \$2,000 for each project with an energy storage component that meets the eligibility requirements and has a renewable energy component that is concurrently awarded funding through the REF Small Scale program.

Maximize Your Renewable Energy ROI

Purchasing a solar PV system generally requires up-front installation and equipment costs, but there are significant benefits that are realized over time including avoided electricity costs and net metering. Upfront costs can be offset by the following:

- Federal Tax Credit a 30% federal Investment Tax Credit for qualified projects
- REF Grant Program a 10 25% subsidy
- Get an Energy Audit decrease your electric load
 - * Project must meet a TSRF (shade analysis) requirement of 80% or higher to qualify for a grant.
