

## Renewable Energy Fund: Commercial-Scale Program

## Are you considering a large-scale solar project?

If you are a business, nonprofit, academic institution, municipal/state building or other large facility, you may be eligible for the REF grant program!

The Rhode Island Commerce Corporation can help you drastically lower your electric bills with grants for renewable energy that could cover up to 30% of renewable energy installation costs. Combined with the Federal Investment Tax Credit (ITC) of 30%, a grant from REF can bring payback periods down to 5 to 8 years, depending on the project.

## 2023 Commercial Scale Grant Incentives

Direct Ownership	Carport (Adder of \$0.55)	System Size	Energy Storage Adder
\$0.70/W	\$1.25/W	For the first 0-50kW	\$0.50/W

\$0.30/W	\$0.85/W	For the 3 <sup>rd</sup> 50kW (up to 150kW)	
\$0.20/W	\$0.75/W	For the 4 <sup>th</sup> 50kW (up to 200kW)	
\$0.20/W	\$0.75/W	For the 5 <sup>th</sup> 50kW (201kW and up)	

- Maximum Grant = \$75,000 per application and \$150,000/installer/round
- Maximum Grant for Carport = \$200,000
- All funding levels are subject to change. Notification towards changes would be made a block prior.

- 1) Non- profits may apply for a Third-party-owned (PPA or Lease) system using pages 5 and 6 on the Commercial application template or 2) Non-profits may apply using the direct ownership application.
